# SUMMER READING 2017-2018 ONLINE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

Dear families of upcoming 7th graders,

In the past, students have taken their summer reading tests during the first week of school. We, the 7th grade English/Language Arts department, are trying to better your experience with summer reading. We are going to have online assessments available, and we are piloting something new this year. We want all students to see that we read every day of our lives, and that it is important to read fiction and nonfiction, to read for information and for pleasure. So, instead of reading a novel, each student will read one short story, two nonfiction articles about the importance of reading, and then he/she will have the opportunity to earn up to 16 bonus points for the start of the year. Your child must read the short story, "A Retrieved Reformation" by O. Henry, and the two nonfiction articles (compiled on a document together) during the summer. After reading the selections, the students will take an online assessment for each selection. There is an online test for the short story, and there is a separate test for the nonfiction articles. The two assessments will total 50 points. The bonus points will be a separate grade, and the instructions are on page two.

<u>All students MUST take the summer reading tests online by the first day of school, August 9<sup>th</sup>.</u> We will be doing an assignment the first week of school regarding these selections, and we need each student to have taken the test in order for the assignment to work. Please know there are many ways to take the online tests:

- 1. You may take it at home using the links provided.
- 2. You may go to the Trussville Public Library and use the computers if needed.
- 3. You may take the test on a mobile device using a Wi-Fi spot here in town. There are several places that have free Wi-Fi available, and here a few places we know of for sure
  - a. Chick-Fil-A
  - b. Starbucks
  - c. McDonald's
  - d. Momma Goldberg's

After reading the above texts, you are to take there will be certain requirements while taking the test online to ensure a reliable testing method. Please read these carefully:

- You are only allowed to take each test one time. Make sure to use your name as it is shown in iNow.
- With each test, you will have 45 minutes, the length of a class period, to take the test. It will not allow you to start and stop.
- You MAY use the text on the test. Be careful about the time you spend searching to answer a question. It will shut off the test after 45 minutes.

Please click the link below that matches each selection and take each test. Make sure to read the directions for EACH question. At the end of each test, you will submit once. It will then allow you to see ALL your answers at one time, and you can change some answers if needed. Then, you will be asked to submit it for the final time. You will not be able to go back and change an answer at this point. Also, please know you do not have to do both tests in the same day. Good luck! We believe you can do this. ©




## BONUS ASSIGNMENT OPPORTUNITY

If a student wishes to earn bonus points during the summer, we have created an opportunity for that. By participating in this assignment, students will see just how often their reading skills are used. The assignment is found in Google Classroom. If you wish to do the assignment, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Students should sign into Google and **use their .ORG account**. (This is the same sign in information they used on the Chromebook during the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.)
- 2. Go to www.classroom.google.com and select the PLUS sign in the top right corner:



5. When you type the code in, you will be entered into the **Summer Reading 2017-2018 – Bonus Opportunity** class. You should then be able to see the assignment posted. Click the OPEN button in the top right corner of the post. You will then be able to open the assignment and read the instructions.



- 6. Please follow the instructions for the assignment, and you must click TURN IN when finished. This document can be worked on throughout the summer, and it will save your changes as you go. It does not have to be completed all in one day.
- 7. If you are new to the system and do not have a Google account through Trussville City Schools, or you do not have access to the internet in order to complete the bonus opportunity, you may PRINT the document and complete the assignment on paper. It must be turned into your teacher the first week of school. It will not be accepted after August 11, 2017.
