***Animal Farm* by George Orwell, Penguin Publishing Group, 2004, ISBN 9780451526342.** As ferociously fresh as it was more than a half century ago, this remarkable allegory of a downtrodden society of overworked, mistreated animals, and their quest to create a paradise of progress, justice, and equality is one of the most scathing satires ever published. As we witness the rise and bloody fall of the revolutionary animals, we begin to recognize the seeds of totalitarianism in the most idealistic organization; and in our most charismatic leaders, the souls of our cruelest oppressors.

***The Wizard of Oz* by Frank Baum, Harper Collins Publishers, 2001, ISBN 9780688166779.** Dorothy thinks she's lost forever when a tornado whirls her and her dog, Toto, into a magical world.
