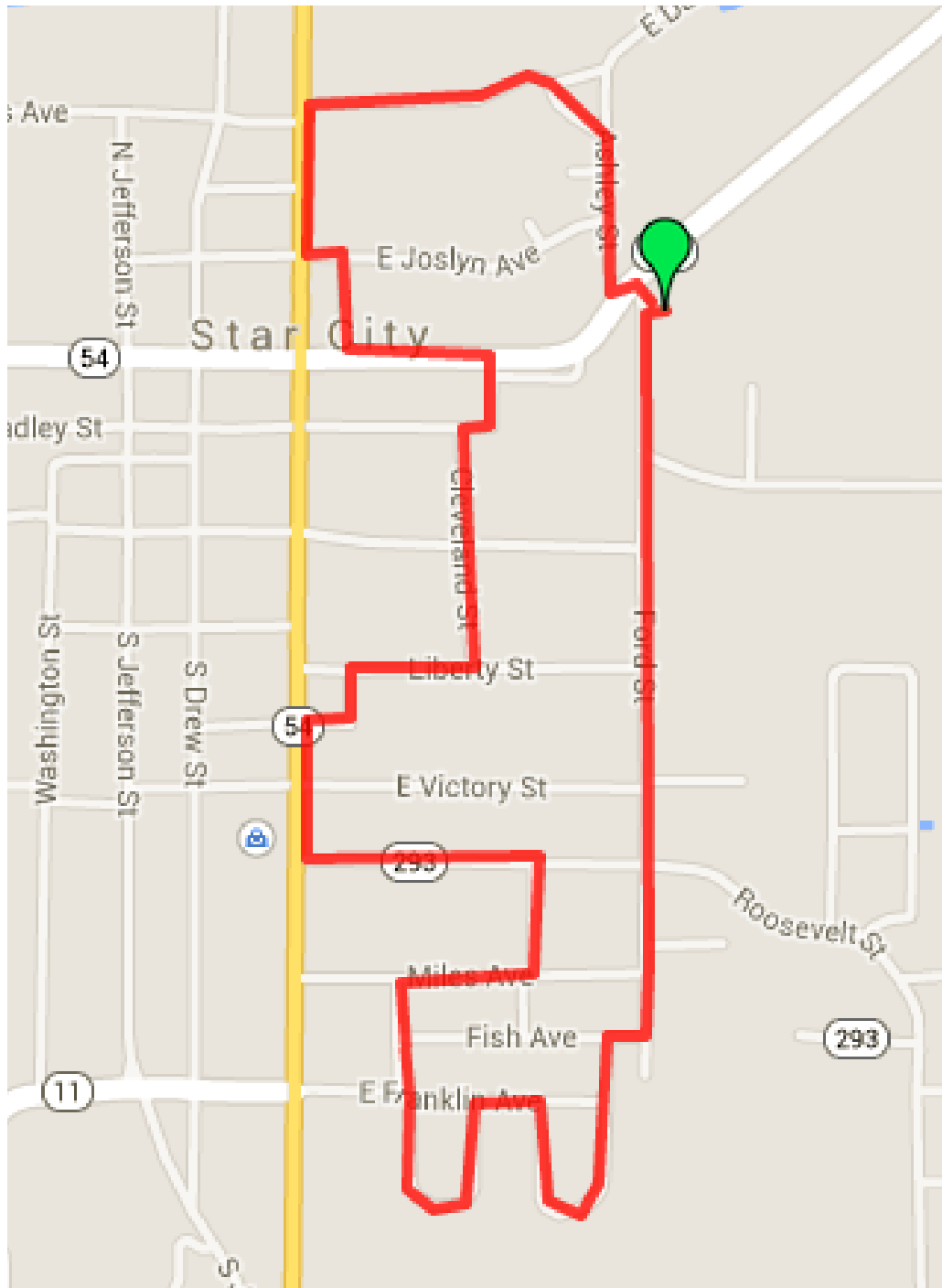

*The colored corn starch used for the powder has the potential to stain, so be sure to dress accordingly.

*The powder will be thrown in the air, and will be sprayed at participants at the color stations so those with breathing problems will want to walk around and/or wear masks or bandanas. You may also want to wear some sunglasses or other protective eye wear as participants tend to get very enthusiastic with the powder!
