

# MUSD ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

## Student Dress Code Information

The school district has the responsibility to promote the basic rules of sanitation, safety, neatness and modesty while on campus. Students will dress in a manner that, in addition to the following guidelines, takes into consideration the educational environment, safety, health, and welfare of self and others. Students will not dress in a manner that disrupts the learning process. Each student will keep in mind that he/she is a representative of the Maricopa Unified School District and the Maricopa community. The school administrator will make final determinations on school appropriate attire. The following is a summary of dress code guidelines.

## Dress Code Guidelines:

**All clothing must be school appropriate, fit correctly, be clean and without rips or fraying, or contain any graphic or logo that is offensive, or contributes negatively to the learning environment.**

### Students may wear:

- Shirts with sleeves
- Dresses, shorts, skorts, pants, capri pants, or jeans
- Skorts, shorts, dresses and skirts that are fingertip length when arms are resting naturally at the side
- Shoes that fasten securely in the back
- Shoes with heels less than two inches
- Hanging or loop earrings that are shorter than 1/2 inch

### Students may NOT wear:

- Shirts without sleeves such as tank tops or spaghetti strap tops
- Tights or leggings worn alone
- Tight, baggy, oversized, undersized or see-through clothing
- Undergarments that show
- Flip-flops or other shoes without backs
- Shoes with wheels (heelies)
- Hats, hoods, or sunglasses in the building (playground only)
