Qualifications:

- 1) Applicants must earn a minimum of 10 points. At least 4 points must be from LIST I (except seniors applying in Feb or June). The first 7 points (total) must come from a combination of List I and List II (all 10 points may come from List 1).
- 2) **ONLY 5 COURSES** MAY BE USED TO QUALIFY.
- 3) NO CSF points are given for Physical Education, subjects repeated for a grade change, student clerk, teacher's assistant, or pass/fail credit classes.
- 4) CSF points are granted as follows:
 A = 3 pts
 B = 1 point
 C = 0 pts
 D or F in ANY COURSE is an automatic disqualification.

Note: A or B grade in an Honors or AP course may earn 1 extra point each, for a maximum of 2 points. (Making the maximum number of points possible 17 points).

Important Information:

- Semester membership is based on work done in previous semester. Under very limited circumstances, summer school may be used. See advisor.
- You must **REAPPLY and QUALIFY EACH SEMESTER.**
- Courses must be from List 1, 2, and 3 on reverse side.
