The Robert J. Allen Memorial Scholarship intends to support those who have lost a loved one to suicide. Furthermore, this scholarship aims to bring awareness and support to those whom suicide profoundly impacts, namely friends, acquaintances, and most importantly, family.

Scholarship recipients will be selected on a combination of merit and financial need. Each scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000 and will go directly to the recipient's choice of further education. The number of scholarships awarded will depend on funding.

The application cycle opens on 1 March and closes 30 April.

Applications should include the following:

- 1. Biographical data.
- 2. Photo of the applicant (to be used in website, newsletter, or social media posts).
- 3. Two letters of recommendation, one being of a personal nature (coach, manager, etc.), one from academic support (teacher, counselor, etc.).
- 4. Responses to three short answer questions.
- 5. Essay response.
- 6. Cover letter (optional).
