Dear Scholar and Parent:

The Tahoe Truckee Community Scholarship Committee (TTCSC) represents over 80 local individual scholarship granting agencies. The Tahoe Truckee Community Scholarship is open to scholars who plan to attend a vocational/technical school, a community college, or a 4-year college. The screening committee will base their selections on four criteria: Scholastic, Personal (essay and staff rating), Extracurricular Activities (community service, sports, work, scholar government, clubs, etc.), and Financial Need. In some specific scholarships, financial need is considered. The information provided by the scholar and parent in each section will be reviewed by the committee without knowledge of the applicant's identity. Since the TTCS selection committee will not know the identities of the scholarship applicants, it is important that the application provides true insight into the scholar. Scholarships for Truckee High scholars will be awarded at Evening of Excellence, scholarships for North Tahoe High scholars will be awarded at Commencement.

- 2. The recommendation form should be completed as soon as possible by a non-family member. Last page of the application

Parent Directions:

- 2. Guide your scholar to a person for a recommendation who can evaluate their most positive attributes.
- 3. Review your scholar's application for accuracy.
