



REPORT CARD

Measure A is a local school parcel tax that was first passed by a 2/3 majority in 1989. It has been renewed four times: in 1993, 1997, 2001 and 2005. It collects \$98 per parcel annually and generates approximately \$4 million each year for the benefit of students in the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District. This vital support to our school will expire in 2012.

Truckee High School receives funding in specific areas that are mandated by Measure A and are listed below. Expenditure of funds is reviewed and approved by a district-wide Measure A Citizens Review Committee.

Total expenditures at **Truckee High School** for this school year are \$635,848. The staff and students of our school thank this community for their support of our students' education.

In addition, Measure A provides district-wide funding for art supplies, computer lab replacements, transportation, playgrounds/grounds safety upgrades, and salaries for positions such as Librarians, Nurses, and Technology Support.
