Dear Second Grade Families,

Welcome to unit two in literacy!!

Focus

This second unit will focus on non-fiction reading and writing. Students will think about why they read informational text (to better understand the world around them) and how they read it (in contrast to fiction). They will look at details writers choose to include in text, and how that information fits together, to help them generate ideas about topics. As writers, they will write all about a topic on which they have some knowledge and work towards putting information together in order to convey an idea.

Home Support

You can help your child at home in several ways:

- Encourage your child to read every night.
- Talk with your child about what they read. Ask about (in non-fiction):
 - The topic (what is it?),
 - The details the author chooses to present,
 - How the details the author presents are related to each other,
 - What the details make us think about the topic.
- Find the best time and place for homework and establish a routine.
- Talk to your child about his/her day at school. Share the day's ups and downs.
- Look at the work your child brings home. Praise your child for his/her hard work!
