23 Juniors and Seniors Invited to Apply to National Honor Society



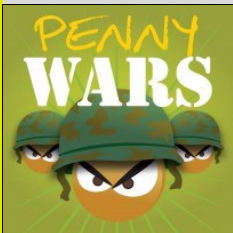
GROTON, CT - Today, twenty-three juniors and seniors were invited to apply to the Marine Science Magnet High School National Honor Society Chapter.
