

At the January PTO Meeting, the topic of SAT and ACT notification and information was mentioned as a need for improvement. In response to this suggestion, we would like to give the upcoming dates for the ACT and SAT. We recommend that current Juniors take both the SAT and ACT this May and June and once again in September and October of their Senior Year.

This school year, all juniors will take the SAT for free at MSMHS on Wednesday, March 2, 2016. The Connecticut State Department of Education has adopted the SAT exam as the statewide assessment in lieu of the Smarter Balanced Assessment for grade 11 public school students. Our MSMHS mathematics and language arts teachers will be preparing our students for the SAT.
