Alyssa Jackson Selected for Governor's Scholars Award Program



GROTON, CT - Alyssa Jackson has been named a nominee for the Connecticut Association of Schools Governor's Scholars Award. The award is given to the top 80+ juniors in Connecticut based upon class rank, CAPT scores, and PSAT scores from this past Fall. Alyssa will have an opportunity to become a finalist where she will be invited to attend the Governor's Scholars awards presentation, receive a plague and have the opportunity to enrich her studies on a college campus before graduating.

The junior from Clinton, scored in the 96th percentile amongst all PSAT takers in the United States. Moreover, Alyssa finished in the 99th percentile in the nation for reading and writing. She one of three MSMHS students to score above a 1300 overall (combined math and reading/writing) on the PSAT.
