Mrs. Hardison Named UConn ECE Teacher of the Year



GROTON, CT - On Thursday, April 28th, Colleen Hardison will receive one of the six awards being given by the University of Connecticut at the UConn Early College Experience Awards held at the Alumni Center at UConn Storrs. Hardison will be receiving the UConn Instructor Award for Excellence in Course Instruction.
