Last week, the Trustees of The Eugene Atwood Award named MSMHS Senior Class President, Priscilla Eang, one of three recipients of the major \$4,000 scholarship. The scholarship will award Priscilla \$1,000 a year towards her four year degree.

Applicants from 19 high schools were selected for the scholarship that was established in 1916 by Mr. Eugene Atwood of Stonington, CT. The purpose of the scholarship is to aid deserving, industrious young people who are making an honest effort to accomplish the best results in life.

Priscilla is a member of the National Honor Society who holds leadership positions as the President of the senior class and student council representative. She ranks in the top 5 of her class with a 4.30 GPA and is enrolled in a rigorous schedule that includes AP Psychology, AP/ECE Biology, AP Statistics and ECE American Studies. By the end of her career at MSMHS, Priscilla will have opportunity to transfer 36 college credits to her next place of education.
