This year's Open House here at New Milford High School will be held on **Thursday, September 26, 2019** and will include an opportunity for parents to follow your child's schedule, meet the teachers, and learn of the courses your child is studying this year. **Please watch your e-mail on Tuesday, 9/24, when we will send another copy of your child's A and B Day schedules or you can retrieve your schedules from the parent portal.** When viewing the schedules, cross off Lunch, Advisory (A Day schedule), and 3TRGroup (B Day schedule). These do not count as instructional periods and will not meet during Open House. **Bring these schedules with you on Thursday evening to assist you in navigating through eight periods of ten minutes each.** I will make a presentation about the new graduation credit requirements to all grade 9 parents who were unable to attend the orientation session held this summer beginning at 6:15 p.m. in the theatre. The new requirements align with Public Act 17-42 and go into effect for the class of 2023.

The format of the evening does not allow for individual conferences between parents and teachers. Rather, the purpose of this program is to acquaint you with the curriculum your child is studying and the specific expectations each teacher has for the students. Individualized conferences are held in November and March. Sign up for these conferences will take place through the high school website as we get closer to those dates.

If you have more than one student at the high school, you may choose to attend any combination of their classes. When a study period is scheduled, you are free to stop in at the Library Learning Commons or the Career Center where our guidance counselors will be.
