

NORTH HAVEN PUBLIC SCHOOLS EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM

Thank you for your interest in our Early Childhood Preschool program that services preschool age student(s) district-wide. Our classrooms are located at Green Acres Elementary School. The Early Childhood Program is NAEYC accredited inclusive preschool program. The preschool utilizes typically developing peers within each classroom as models of age-appropriate social skills, behavior, and language for our children with special needs. Typical peers receive access to a standards-based early learning curriculum that aligns with *CT Early Learning and Development Standards*, as well as the benefits of a developmentally appropriate and play-based learning environment. Our early childhood staff consists of certified Special Education Teachers, Speech and Language Pathologist, Social Worker, and School Psychologist and Paraprofessionals. We provide half day sessions from 8:45-11:25 and 12:20 -3:00. All typical role models must be potty trained to attend the program. **All three- year old children applying for this program must be residents of North Haven and provide proof of residency at Green Acres Elementary School prior to attending a screening session.**

To: Parents/Guardians of All Preschool Age Children
RE: Proof of Residency

All parents of children ages 3 - 21 must register their child in the North Haven Public Schools. Parents of three year old children who are referred to the Early Childhood Preschool (located at the Green Acres School) must register their child. Parents need to provide the necessary documentation outlined below and must complete registration forms at the Assistant Superintendent's office, which is located at:

Necessary documentation to register in the North Haven Public Schools:

1. Valid Driver's License for stated address
2. Copy of two (2) utility bills with stated address.
3. Copy of mortgage statement or lease/rental agreement with stated address.

Educational services cannot be provided without appropriate documentation and completion of registration forms as outlined above. Therefore, all parents of preschool age children must register their child prior to considering a referral to the Early Childhood Preschool for initial screening and/or participation as a typical role model.
