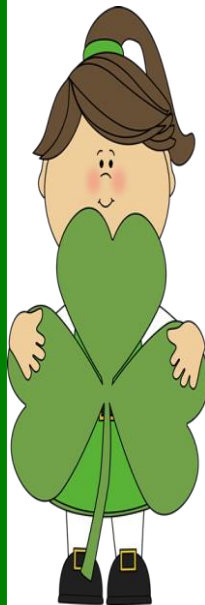

Reading Workshop

The boys and girls have been hard at work learning more strategies to decode difficult words. The students learned to be the boss of their reading by:

1. Stopping at the first sign of the problem
2. Trying a strategy
3. Try something else to get the job done
4. Triple checking their words by asking themselves if the word sounds right, looks right, and make sense.

The class has done an excellent job and continue to work closely with their reading partners to practice retelling parts of a story.
