

Writing

Recently, we have launched our opinion writing unit. The class is writing on opinions supported by reasons with examples

Math

The students have begun our chapter on addition and subtraction and are doing a great job regrouping to the thousands place.

The class continues to improve in their ability to solve word problems. Each week we focus on solving a problem by showing four components: visual model, computation, equation, and word sentences.

In calendar math, focus is on time to the minute and using mental math to compute change.
