GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To earn a North Haven High School diploma a student in the class of 2018 must accrue 24 credits in grades 9 through 12 to include the following:

Additionally students must complete 40 hours of community service and

complete the school learning expectations.

THE SCHEDULE

NHHS employs a block schedule (A/B 4x4) in which eight (8) periods occur over a two-day cycle. This format provides an increase in scheduled instructional time over traditional models and additional course selection opportunities.

CLASS RANK

Students are ranked according to weighted GPA at the conclusion of their Junior year which include courses from grades 9, 10, and 11. To be included in the rank, students must have been enrolled for a minimum of four (4) consecutive semesters. All graded credit-bearing courses (excluding those graded as Pass/Fail) are included in the GPA and class rank. GPA is determined by multiplying the earned credits by the course weight and dividing the sum by total potential credits.
