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What Are Student Success Plans?

Student Success Plans (SSPs) are individualized plans that are student driven and support student growth in three areas:

- Academic Development
- College/Career Development
- Social/Emotional/Physical Development

The purpose is to help students learn more about themselves, their strengths, and areas of interest. Students can set and monitor personal goals related to their own future planning.

Why SSPs?

SSPs are part of the secondary education reform legislation that took effect July 1, 2012

Who Is responsible For The SSPs?

SSPs are a school-wide endeavor. Each year, students will work on a piece of their SSP independently, through classes, in Advisory, and with the School Counselors. Students will document SSP work in an electronic portfolio. Documentation may include:

- Journal reflections
- Projects
- Assessments
- Surveys
- Essays
- Portfolios will be housed electronically in Naviance.



What Is Naviance?

Naviance is a web based tool that helps students and families connect what students do in the classroom to their life goals, including finding colleges and careers based on their personal skills and areas of interests.

Some things students can do in Naviance are:

- Explore Careers
- Take Interest Inventories
- Research Colleges & Scholarships
- Submit transcripts to Colleges
- Register to visit with college representatives
- Communicate with counselors and teachers
