Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students:

Students in Foundations I at the high school used the Moby Max website to practice a variety of math concepts and skills throughout the school year. 8th grade students used Moby Max as well as iReady. Students will continue to have access to these websites over the summer. The purpose of students practicing using these programs is two-fold. First, is to keep math skills at the same level or higher than when the school year ended. Second, is to help students and teachers identify the prerequisite concepts and skills that each student has and has not mastered.

Students should complete a minimum of 4 hours of Moby Max and/or iReady over the summer. Students entering 9th grade will have access to both. Both programs will provide a variety of lessons to meet the needs of each student. Students should keep track of their progress in the log provided (see back of this sheet) and bring the completed log to school on the first day of class.

To access Moby Max, go to: www.mobymax.com/signin. Students will then be asked to enter their username and password. This is the same username and password that they have used throughout the year.
