STANDARDS FOR GRADUATION



1. Four credits in **English**
2. Three credits in **Social Studies**, one credit must be in U.S. History and one-half credit in Civics
3. Three credits of **Mathematics**
4. Two credits of **Science**, one of which must be a Biological Science and one a Physical Science



5. Three elective credits within the 2 elective categories - 1.) **Art, Humanities, Music,** and 2.) **CTE courses (Business Education, Family and Consumer Sciences, and Technology Education).**
6. One credit in an **Advanced course** which would be in addition to the three Credits indicated in item #5
7. One credit in **Physical Education**



8. One- half credit in **Health**
9. One-half credit in **Computer Literacy**.
10. One-half credit in **Freshman Seminar**.
11. An additional three and one-half credits in elective courses.
