

Smoking

Smoking, e-cigarettes, or the use of smokeless tobacco is not permitted by students on or about Board of Education property. Violation of the smoking rule could result in dismissal from the Summer School Program.

Dress Code

The school expects that the individual's dress and cleanliness reflect a sensitivity to and respect for others and that his/her attire will not be distracting to staff and other students. Although this is not an attempt to include all items, the following more common types of clothing are excluded:

- Any article of clothing that covers any part of the face or head, including hats, bandanas, and all other types of head coverings are not permitted, unless for religious purposes.
- Articles having indecent or inflammatory writing, pictures, slogans or displaying alcohol or other illegal substances.
- An article of clothing that could cause damage to other students or property (chain belts, cleats, studded accessories or belts, wristbands, etc.)
- Short shorts and halter-tops - shorts can be defined as gym length or less: halter-tops include half shirts - no midriff exposed.
- No thin strapped shirts, or shirts with wide cut arm holes or that reveal underclothes.
- Clothing or accessories that symbolize membership in a group which could be construed as disruptive to the educational process.

School Property

Since all textbooks, equipment, lockers, desks and other school property belong to the Board of Education, a student will be assessed for any damages as well as for items lost or stolen. If these items are not returned or paid for, the school may withhold the issuance of transcripts and/or report cards until the obligation has been cleared.

Parking

Students are to park only in the student parking area, which is located on the right side of the building as you enter the campus.

Food and Drinks

Students are not allowed to eat or drink in school or on school property.

Middletown Cooperative Summer School Regulations 2017 - 2018

The disciplinary regulations at Middletown High School are designed and implemented to ensure successful operation of the education program.

Attendance

- Students are only allowed **two absences**; the third absence in a class will result in dismissal from summer school and/or loss of credit(s).
- Three times tardy to a class will equal one absence.
- Any tardy beyond 10 minutes to class will be considered an absence.

Dismissal from Summer School

The opportunity to attend summer school is a privilege. Any offense occurring during summer school that would cause a student to be suspended during the regular school year at Middletown High School could result in **dismissal** from summer school. The following are examples:

- Carrying any type of weapon (mace, pepper gas, knife, etc.)
- Fighting - *When a teacher's verbal commands for fighting to stop are ignored, a breach of peace is indicated and an arrest may be requested.*
- Threatening.
- Assault.
- Sexual harassment.
- Insubordination.
- Any behavior which threatens or endangers the school community.
- Damage to any school property including textbooks, computer hardware and software, lockers, etc.
- Pulling a fire alarm.
- Theft.
- Use/possession of alcoholic beverages or drugs.
- Class disruption.
- Using profane/obscene language or gestures.
- Failure to comply with a directive from a teacher/administrator/staff member.
- Failure to provide his/her name when requested by a staff member.
- Unfriendly contact with a staff member or fellow student.

The Administration reserves the right to involve police when appropriate.

Headphones and cell phones

Students are not allowed to have headphones or cell phones during summer school.
