

Fall 2018 High School Partnership Program

Program Criteria

The program is open to high school juniors and seniors, who have at least an overall "B" average, are ranked in the top 20% of their class, and are recommended by you. Students who are accepted into the program will be eligible to take one course free of charge (General Fund tuition and fees). Students will be responsible for their transportation to the campus and book expenses. **Please do not recommend students unless they meet and understand the above criteria.**

Students should be informed that they must have appropriate placement scores and meet college prerequisites for the class they wish to take.

Application Process

Students must submit a one-page MxCC High School Partnership Program application. Students do not pay an application fee. The application, a current copy of the student's transcript, and counselor recommendations should be forwarded to MxCC through your office.

The application deadline is **May 18, 2018**. All completed paperwork must be submitted to the Office of Enrollment Services by this date. *No exceptions will be granted after May 18th.*

Course Registration Information

This is important information for your students, please share it with them.

Students applying to the program will be notified of their acceptance in writing by the Middlesex Community College Office of Enrollment Services by June 8, 2018. *Submitting an application to the program does not guarantee acceptance.*

Students must arrange to take the Accu-Placer Student Assessment **after** they have been accepted into the program and prior to registration for their class. Once they receive their acceptance letter, which includes a student identification number (BANNER ID), students should visit our website (www.mxcc.edu/bsa) for test information. Students who have previously taken the assessment are not required to take it again. **Please note: SAT or ACT scores do not exempt High School Partnership students from taking the basic skills assessment.**

Students accepted into the Program will be informed directly through the Office of Enrollment Services as to the date of their registration appointment. *Students are responsible for the cost of all required textbooks and materials.*
