Program fees are \$35 per registered course credit plus a \$20 resource fee. Please see attached course list to determine credits per course. The University of Connecticut sends fee notifications to the e-mail address the student provides during the application process. Students are financially responsible for all courses for which they register. University standard policies on late fees, returned checks, and collections will apply to program participants.\*

ADD/DROP PERIOD (August 15, 2017- September 29, 2017)

A \$25 non-refundable processing fee is charged during the add/drop registration period. This fee is in addition to the program fees listed above. Courses must be dropped online in the Compass Enrollment Center on or before September 29, 2017 to result in a refund of already paid program fees minus the \$25 processing fee. Courses dropped after September 29, 2017, will require a WAU (withdrawn audit) form to be completed and all course fees to be paid.\*

FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) & AUTHORIZED USERS

## Key Dates

<b>April 24</b>	Online registration systems open.
<b>June 1</b>	<b>Application deadline.</b> An application must be successfully submitted online prior to enrolling in courses.
<b>June 30</b>	<b>Course enrollment deadline.</b> Online registration closes. Any further transactions must be made during the add/drop period and will incur an additional \$25 add/drop processing fee.
<b>August 15</b>	<b>Add/Drop period begins.</b> Online registration systems re-open.
<b>September 15</b>	<b>Late application deadline.</b> Any student who did not successfully submit a 2017-2018 application by June 1st must do so by September 15, 2017.
<b>September 29</b>	<b>Late enrollment deadline</b> for adding or dropping courses with a \$25 add/drop processing fee. Courses dropped after September 29, 2017, will require a WAU (withdrawn audit) form to be completed and all course fees to be paid.
<b>November 22</b>	<b>Fall and Full-Year course fees are due.</b> A \$50 late fee will be assessed to all accounts which go unpaid after the published fee bill due date.
<b>January 8</b>	<b>Spring course fees are due.</b> A \$50 late fee will be assessed to all accounts which go unpaid after the published fee bill due date.

## ENROLL in Courses

*(It will take 3-5 business days for your application to be processed before you are approved to enroll in courses. Once approved you will receive an e-mail to enroll.)*

- Click the link in your approval e-mail or visit [ece.uconn.edu](http://ece.uconn.edu) to enroll in your courses.
- Log in to the Compass Enrollment Center with your activated NetID and password.
- Add all approved Fall and Spring courses to your shopping cart. *Check with your high school for correct course/term designations.*
- Validate and Enroll ("class successfully added to your schedule" confirmation message will pop-up).

### Do you know about FERPA Waivers & Authorized Users?

For your parent/guardian to receive information regarding your fee bill you must complete a FERPA waiver online. If you designate your parent/guardian as an Authorized User they can log in on your behalf and receive an e-mail notification of your fee bill!
