



Center School PowerSchool Parent Portal Gradebook and Report Card Viewer

Logging into PowerSchool

Each parent has their own unique username and password. We previously sent username and password information home, but if you have misplaced your information or need support, please contact the main office. You can access your child's information wherever you have internet access via <https://ps.wilmingtonct.org/public>. PowerSchool also has an app that can be downloaded for free.

Home Screen

The screen below is the home screen (click **PowerSchool** in the top left corner of your screen to return to this page) and provides a direct route to attendance, grades, and lunch balance. You can receive **Email Notifications** when your child's teacher(s) input grades by clicking on the link on the left side of the page. To view your child's report card, click on the **Standards Grades** tab. **Click Here** brings you to your child's assignment grades.

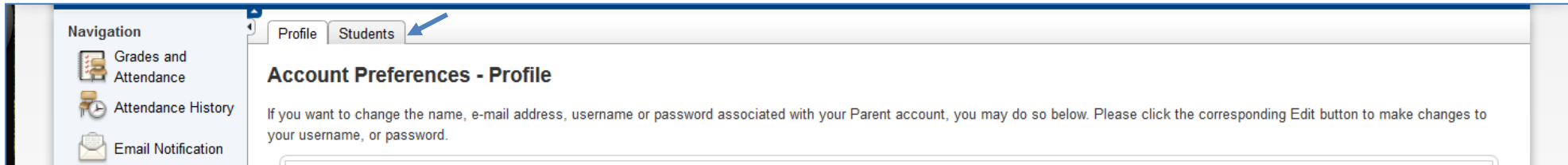




Mobile View

You can see your child's report card(s) from previous years by clicking on the **Grade History** on the left side of the screen. Once you click **Grade History**, click on the **Standards Grades History** tab. If your child has been at Center School for more than one year, multiple years will be displayed and you can click on any other year to view their report card. See the picture below. Also, using this view you can see all the comments at the bottom of the page.
