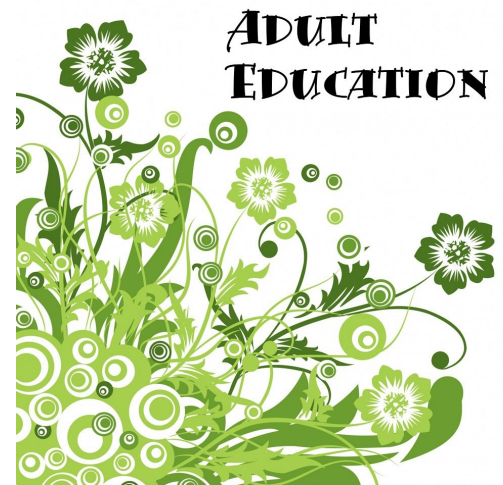
FSC Kindness Mission

FSC Welcomes New Members to Our Team

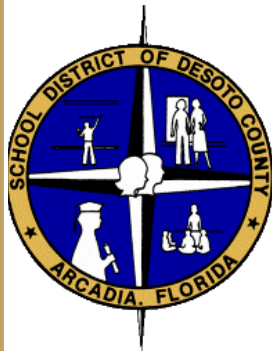
