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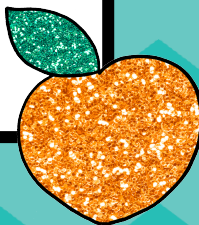

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## Inferential Questions to Ask (DURING READING)

Background Knowledge + Text Clue + Inferences

- Why...
- Why do you think...
- What is the problem?
- Why did the character...
- What can you conclude about...
- What is most likely true about...?
- Predict what would happen if...
- Predict what will happen when...
- What lesson does this story teach?
- How does the character feel about...?
- How did the character act when...?
- What generalization can you make?
- What lesson did the character learn?
- From this story, you could probably guess...
- What would happen in a sequel to this story?
