GRADUATION DRESS CODE

BOYS White or light blue dress shirt, dark tie (no Bow ties), dark pants (no jeans), dark shoes (no tennis shoes or sandals).

GIRLS Dress, dress shoes or dress sandals, (no tennis shoes or flip flops), jewelry is appropriate as long as it is understated, but elegant.

INFORMATION CONCERNING GRADUATION

Seniors should select a marching partner and give this information to Mrs. Taylor in the office as soon as possible. Along with that information you should know where in the lineup you and your partner would like to be (beginning, middle, or end). We will do our best to make sure that you will be placed there.

Each senior will be given SIX (6) tickets for graduation. Graduation tickets will be used ONLY in the event of inclement weather and the ceremony has to be moved to the gymnasium.

After graduation exercises, each senior will return to the Tiger Den to receive his/her diploma if graduation is at the stadium. Seniors will report to building 7 if graduation is in the Chipley High School gymnasium.

The packet you receive during the graduation exercise will contain only a diploma case. Your diploma will not be given to you until the graduation exercises have been properly carried out and all other obligations met.

Remember...All financial obligations must be settled before you receive your diploma.

The deadline for clearing these obligations is **FRIDAY, MAY 12**. This will include library, lost/damaged textbooks, lunchroom, other fees, jackets, coats or uniforms which have been ordered and charged to individuals. You need to be aware that debts are carried over from year to year. Any debt incurred in a lower grade has been brought forward if it was not previously paid.
