PURPOSE OF PROGRAM

The purpose of the **New Vizh-uhn Educational Award** is to provide financial assistance to students graduating from High School, or presently enrolled in College, University, or Vocational School. While the full need of the student cannot be met, every effort will be made to assist students and parents in identifying and locating financial aid resources to be used to help offset educational cost. This program will assist student and parents with workshops in preparing student for higher education.

GOALS: The goals of the educational awards program are to:

- Identify and support deserving students to achieve their educational goals.
- Provide cash awards to worthy students.
- Assist students and parents in identifying and locating financial resources.
- Prepare them through workshop in learning about a variety of careers.
- Contribute to improving the quality of life for student we serve and their society (physically, mentally, morally, and spiritually)
- Provide counsels, educational, recreational, and social activities.
- Build an awareness of funding opportunities for students.

ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

New Vizh-uhn Educational Award provide assistance to student graduating from High School, or presently enrolled in college, University, or Vocational School.

The selection of students under this program will be based on the following criteria:

- Academic achievement GPA 2.0 or above.
- Personal short essay or video describing career goals, current and past extracurricular activities, etc.
- Recommendation (teacher, guidance counselor, or pastor), and
- Financial needs.

The awards are first based on consideration of criteria above. If two (2) students are considered to be equal, the candidate with the greater financial need is ranked higher. These requirement will be strictly, adhered to by the scholarship committee. **(unresolved tie votes within the scholarship committee will be decided by the Board of Directors)**

AWARD DETERMINATION

The amount of the cash awards given to each student is determined by **New Vizh-uhn Educational Award Program**. The awards are based on financial need. The awards may be up to 1,000 per year, for a maximum of four (4) years, as long as the student remain in good academic standing at the same institution, enrolled in a full-time curriculum, and submits a renewal application. Generally once a student receives an award from **New Vizh-uhn Educational Award Program**, it may be renewed in subsequent years if the student continues to meet the eligibility requirement of the award and if funds are available. However, the renewal of the award is not an automatic process, and is up to the decision of **New Vizh-uhn Educational Award Program**.
