# HONOR PLATOON SELECTION CRITERIA

## CAMP RUDDER JROTC LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE HONOR PLATOON SELECTION CRITERIA

1. <u>GENERAL</u>: The Honor Platoon Selection Program will give cadets attending the Camp Rudder JROTC Cadet Leadership Challenge (JCLC) the opportunity as a member of a team, and as team leaders, to have a hands-on competitive experience while participating in training.

#### 2. REFERENCES:

- 3. <u>PURPOSE</u>: This selection plan provides guidance and instructions for implementation of the Honor Platoon Selection Program, and criteria for the selection of the daily Honor Platoon and selection of the overall Honor Platoon for the 2014 Camp Rudder JCLC.
- 4. <u>PERSONNEL</u>: The JCLC CSM will oversee the implementation of this program under the direction of the JCLC Commandant. All concerned cadre members, staff cadets, and training events OICs will provide input to the selection process IAW this plan.

#### 5. CONCEPT:

- a. One platoon will be selected each day of required training as the Daily Honor Platoon, based on input from that day's Training Events OICs; and daily inspections of that platoon's cadets and areas of responsibility, normally conducted by the Training Company 1SG.
- b. One platoon will be selected at the completion of JCLC to be designated the JCLC Honor Platoon based on the Daily Honor Platoon results, the Safety Platoon Award, and the Platoon Competition results. Members of the JCLC Honor Platoon will be awarded the Commendation Ribbon (N-3-9).

#### 6. DAILY HONOR PLATOON:

a. Daily criteria will include:

- (1) Daily personnel and areas of responsibility inspection results by the Training Company 1SG and Operations NCO. (See Enclosure 1, Daily Barracks Inspection Check List)
- (2) Input from Training Events OICs on platoons' performance during training. (See Enclosure 2, Daily Training Site OIC Evaluation Score Sheet)
- (3) Input from Training Company cadre on platoons' performance while under the direction of the Company cadre.
- (4) Input from the JCLC Commandant and Command Sergeant Major, cadre and cadet staff members, and other observers, as applicable.
- b. Input will be collected and analyzed at the end of the training day by the Operations Officer and submitted for approval to the JCLC Commandant.
- c. Platoons will be ranked 1, 2, 3, & 4, earning 1, 2, 3, & 4 points respectively.
- d. Cadets will normally be notified of the results at the following morning formation. Cadets will be notified of the final day's selection prior to the closing ceremonies.
- e. The Barracks Inspection Sheets and Training Site Evaluation Score Sheets will be distributed to each platoon after notification of the Daily Honor Platoon to provide the platoons with information on deficiencies that can be addressed on subsequent days.
- 7. <u>JCLC HONOR PLATOON</u>: Criteria for selection of JCLC Honor Platoon will include:
  - a. Total of daily points awarded for <u>Daily Honor Platoon</u>.
  - b. Total of points earned in the <u>Platoon Drill Competition</u> following the drill sequence on the **Platoon Drill Score Sheet** (See Enclosure 3). The competition will normally be judged by the JCLC CSM and the Training Company 1SG.
  - c. Total of points in <u>Platoon Competition Events</u>. Scheduled events include the Ski Race, Tug of War, and the Spirit Cheer.
    - (1) Ski Race is between platoon teams of 2 male and 2 female cadets, racing 25 yards, turning, and returning to the starting line.

- (2) Tug of War is between platoon teams of 5 males and 5 females. Double elimination rounds will be used to determine the winner.
- (3) Each platoon is given 2 minutes maximum to present their Spirit Cheer. The Spirit Cheers will normally be judged by the JCLC Commandant, CSM, and Training Company 1SG.
- d. Total points in the <u>Platoon Flag Competition</u> as judged by the JCLC Commandant and CSM, or their designees.
- d. Total points awarded for the <u>Safety Platoon</u> as determined by the JCLC Safety Officer, based on inspection of platoons during training and results of a Safety Knowledge Quiz among the platoon safety officers and one cadet from each squad in their platoon. (See Paragraph 14, Enclosure 4 of the Camp Rudder JCLC Safety SOP)
- e. Platoon standings may be calculated using the Honor Platoon Score Worksheet shown in Enclosure 5.
