




Parents/Guardians,

We are pleased to report to you that we have had a very successful beginning of school. Our top priority is to make sure that students and staff members are safe as we return to face-to-face instruction. We would like to express our thanks to you for your patience, understanding and cooperation as we encounter this new norm of how we are educating our students. We have taken every safety precaution outlined below consistent with CDC guidance, GA Department of Education guidance, and the Department of Public Health:

- temperature checks for faculty, staff and students prior to entering the school building,
- temperature checks for bus drivers and students prior to students loading the buses in the morning,
- wearing a mask at school for faculty, staff and students (will be required),
- cleaning and disinfecting buses twice daily,
- sanitation stations for students,
- water stations for students,
- scheduled restroom breaks that include disinfecting restrooms after use,
- seating charts and social distancing for instructional purposes,
- seating charts for bus students,
- reducing student movement throughout the building,
- serving most breakfasts and lunches in classrooms to reduce the number of students in the lunchroom at one time,
- cleaning and sanitizing the building when all students and staff members have left for the day,
- an on-duty, experienced registered nurse here to screen for potential illnesses,
- a designated quarantine room in the event that an adult or child shows symptoms of COVID-19,
- limited visitation to the school,
- staff, parents and visitors are screened with temperature checks, and
- safety signage is posted throughout the building.



We ask for your continued support and cooperation in helping us with the above mentioned safety procedures in order to protect the students and staff. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me or the school's administration. Help us keep everyone safe! Stop the spread of COVID-19!
