- Bowdon Middle School is **Beating the Odds**, meaning that it performs better than similar schools.

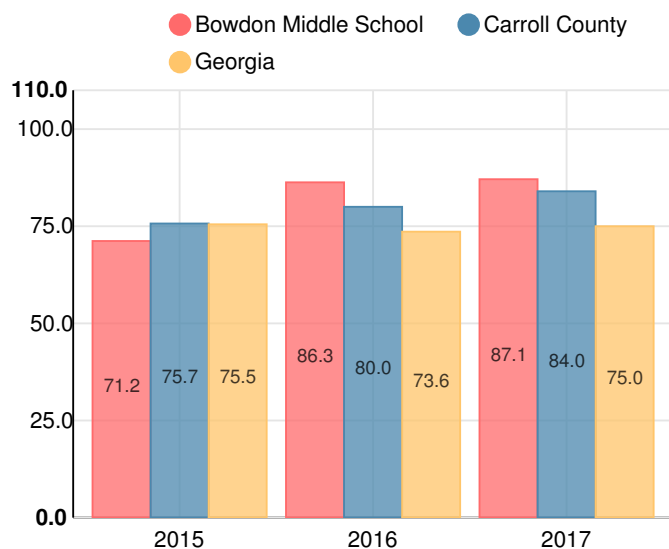

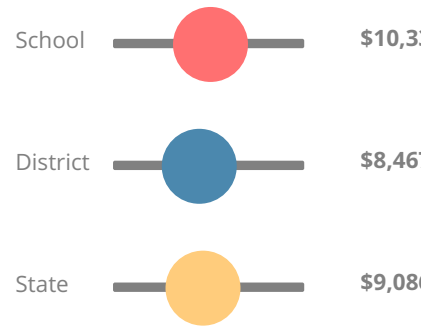

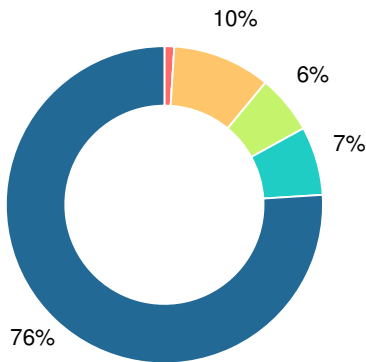


Per Pupil Expenditures

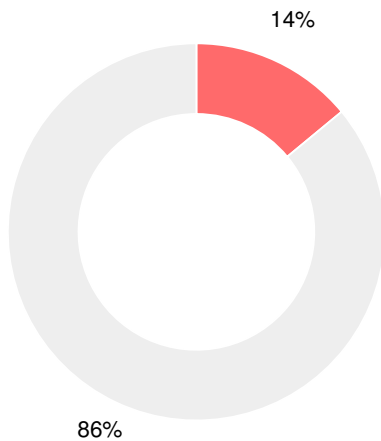

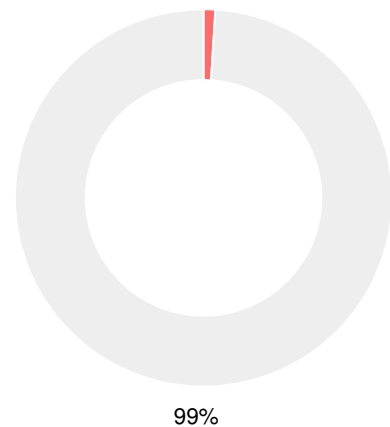

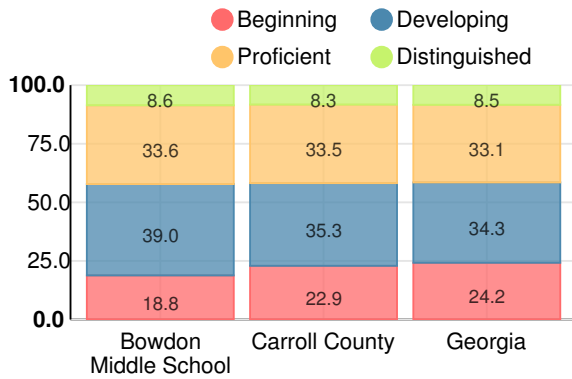

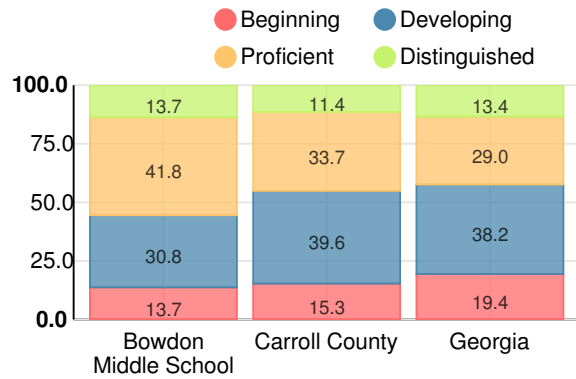

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



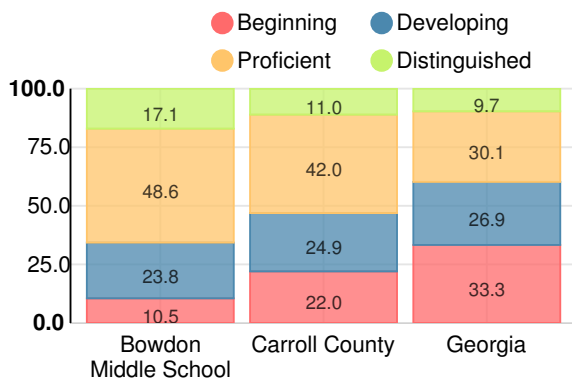
Mathematics

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



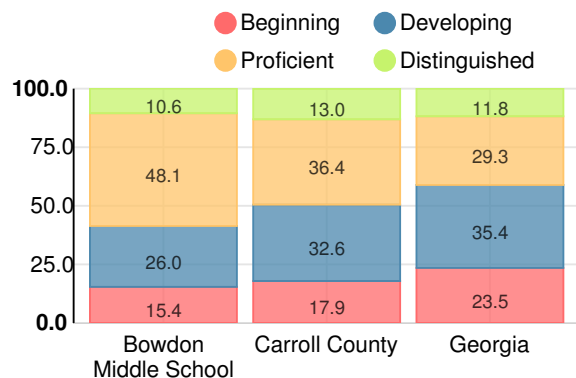
Science
