Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires that parents or guardians who have children attending a Title I school be notified of how well their school is preparing its students for college and/or a career, as well as the school's designation status under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver.

Under the 2015 renewal of Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver, certain Title I schools continue to be designated as Reward, Priority, or Focus Schools. The Waiver allows the use of the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) as the comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia, providing a score between 0-100 for each school - measuring how well the school is doing in preparing its students to be successful in college and/or a career.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is a standard grading system used for all public schools in the state of Georgia. Each year every school is assigned a score between 0 and 100. We are honored that Glanton-Hindsman Elementary School received a CCRPI score of 84.8 for 2015. This score is well above the state elementary school average score of 76. Our score is also the highest CCRPI score in Carroll County School System. I am very proud to tell you that Glanton-Hindsman Elementary has not been given a school designation this year, which means we are a Title I school that is continuing to provide a quality education to all of our students.

Glanton-Hindsman performs very well in all academic areas, and our CCPRI data shows evidence that we are exceptionally strong in the areas of Achievement and Progress. On the 2016 Georgia Milestones, GHE increased our percentage of students who scored proficient and distinguished in seven of the twelve content areas. We also scored above the state average in eleven of the twelve areas.

At Glanton-Hindsman Elementary, we take pride in the teaching we provide for our children. Our teachers and staff members work very hard to meet the needs of all students to ensure they achieve at their highest potential.
