 - **WIDA (World-Class Instructional Design and Assessments)**—the standards that the ESOL Teachers use in the classroom to teach the English language to ESOL Students (English Learners).
 - **ACCESS**—the ACCESS for ELs is a test given each year to ESOL students to monitor the English language development.
