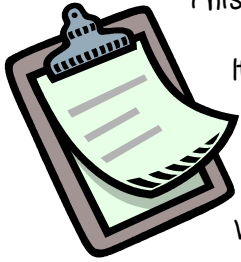

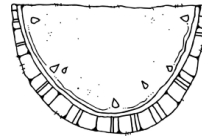


Report Cards
