## GOALS FOR STUDENT LEARNING

**DISTRICT GOAL:** To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient\*--meeting or exceeding standards--in grades 3, 5, and 8 on the first administration of the end of grade assessment

### SCHOOL SECOND GRADE GOALS:

- \* 50% of the students will show at least a 30% growth in ELA/Reading from the beginning of the school year to the end of the school year as measured by Early Literacy
- \* 50% of the students will show at least a 30% growth in Mathematics from the beginning of the school year to the end of the school year as measured by GKIDS/

## BPS Second Grade Teachers

The second grade teachers will work with students and their families to support student success. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Provide parents and students a class web page with listed websites to increase reading and math standard mastery.
- Send home a list of strategies to use at home to increase reading comprehension and higher level thinking skills.
- Send home QR codes each month with links to math problems, problem solving, and critical thinking.
