GOALS FOR STUDENT LEARNING

DISTRICT GOAL:

To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient in grades 3 through 8. also, to improve the percentage of students graduating from high school.

SCHOOL SECOND GRADE GOALS:

- * 60% of the students will show at least a 20% growth in ELA/Reading from the beginning of the school year to the end of the school year as measured by Early Literacy
- * 60% of the students will show at least a 20% growth in mathematics from the beginning of the school year to the end of the school year as measured by GKIDS/STAR

BPS Second Grade Teachers

The second grade teachers will work with students and their families to support student success. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Encourage students to play math games, practice adding & subtracting numbers, and counting to 120 frequently.
- Express to parents/guardians and students the importance of reading on a daily basis.
- Encourage and send home info for students to be able to participate in Reading Egg and Math Seeds web sites at home or on the go.
