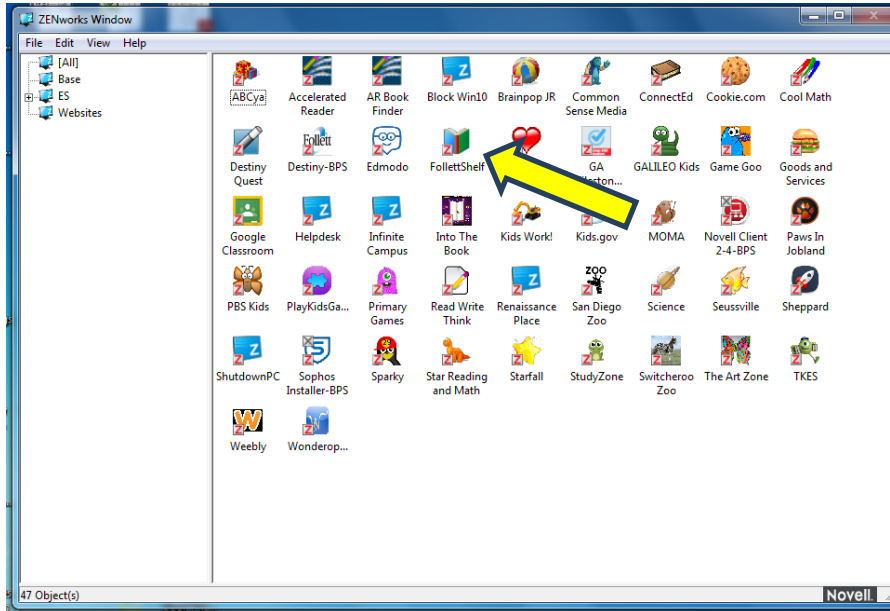


How to Use BPS FollettShelf (eBooks)

We currently have 161 eBooks available online, and most of them are AR books. See the directions below for accessing our eBooks on FollettShelf.

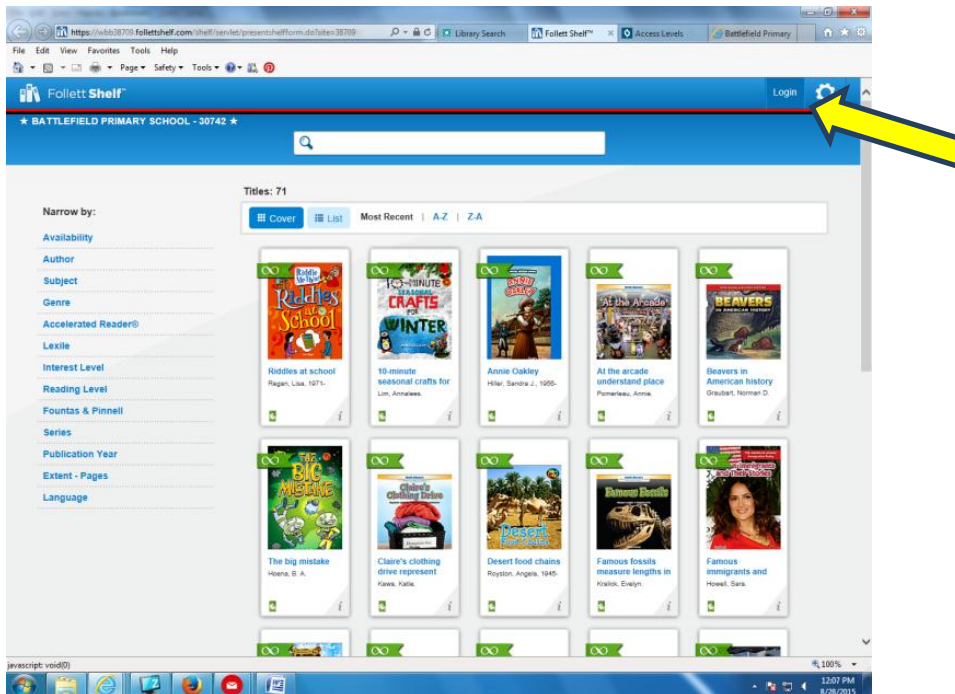
From School:

1. Launch FollettShelf from the Zenworks app launcher.



2. STUDENTS: Log in with your lunch number and birthdate (ex: 3098765 and birthdate 082807).

GUESTS: Login with username "guest" and the password "cub."



3. If you log in as a student, you can check out an eBook, which will allow you to save your place and make virtual notes. However, it is okay to read the eBook without checking it out.

4. You can also access FollettShelf by first logging into Destiny (also found on the app launcher). Logging into Destiny allows you to see what regular items you have checked out, search the catalog, and launch FollettShelf.

From Home:

1. Open FollettShelf from the [BPS Web site](#) by clicking on the link on the navigation sidebar OR by first logging into Destiny Quest, which also has a link on the sidebar.
