

#### An Attitude of Gratitude

Around Thanksgiving, people often talk about what they're thankful for. These activities can inspire your youngster to express gratitude now – and all year long.

#### On the calendar

For the 2017-2018 school year, GES received \$121,632 in Title I funds. Sixty percent of these funds are spent on salaries for our Academic Coach and Parent Involvement Coordinator. Thirty-five percent of these funds are used towards technology resources for our students. We have purchased leases for the following computer programs; IXL, Brain Pop, Lexia, Spelling City, Newsela, easyCBM, Flocabulary, and Reading Eggs. Five percent of these funds are spent on professional development for our teachers.
