## Kindness: Spring in Action

For the 2018-2019 school year, GES received \$145,180 in Title 1 funds. Sixty percent of these funds are spent on salaries for our Academic Coach and Parent Involvement Coordinator. Thirty-five percent of these funds are used towards technology resources for our students. We have purchased leases for the following computer programs; IXL Math, IXL ELA, Brain Pop, Lexia, Spelling (ity, Mathseeds, EasyCBM, Flocabulary, and Reading Eggs. Five percent of these funds are spent on professional development for our teachers.
