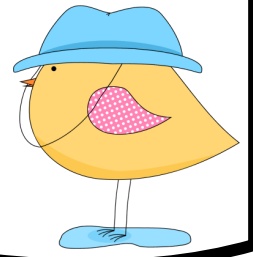

Please note the following testing schedule.

ELA 1 (Writing)	April 23
ELA 2 & 3	April 24
Math	April 25
Science (5th Only)	April 26
Social Studies (5th Only)	April 27

Please make sure that your child is at school on time on these dates. Also, you will need to schedule doctor and dentist appointments around these dates.
