It can be very powerful as students benefit from the expertise of all the teachers on that grade level. By using this process, we can better identify each students' strengths and weaknesses. 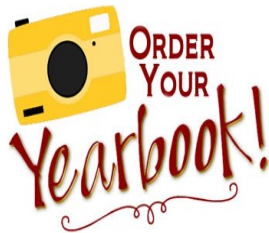
