An excerpt from the March issue...

It's cool to learn new words!

At home or on the go, your youngster can expand her vocabulary. Try these suggestions:

<u>My word wall</u>. Many classrooms have word walls - why not let your child make one at home? Her closet door, a side of the refrigerator, or any other open spot will do. She could write words she is learning on index cards and arrange them by category. *Examples*: History words (*expansion, treaty*), science terms (*photosynthesis, mineral*). Each time she adds a word to her wall, ask her what it means. Then she can refer to the wall as she does her homework or writes stories.

<u>Games to go</u>. In the car, let your youngster pick a random letter (say, G), and take turns calling out something you see that begins with that letter (*grass, gazebo, giri*). If you say and unfamiliar word, point out the item so she learns it. When you reach the next block, someone else can pick a different letter. *Tip*: Later, help her remember the words by asking questions like "What was that round wooden structure that started with G?" (gazebo)
