

Heritage High School Academic Letter APPLICATION 2017

A Heritage High School “letterman” is a student who has met a specified level of participation and/or performance on a varsity athletic team, marching band or in academics. Students must meet eligibility requirements, complete an application, and receive the required faculty signatures to be eligible to be recognized with an Academic Letter. Academic Letters will be awarded at our annual Academic Banquet on Tuesday, May 18th at 6:30 pm. The application process will be held annually after the posting of the 3rd nine weeks grades.

Requirements to receive an Academic Letter:

1) Students must meet both a cumulative grade point average requirement and earn points for participating in extra-curricular academic activities or approved academic competitions. The following scale will be used to determine eligibility to receive an Academic Letter (rounding will be used in determining cumulative grade point average: .5 or higher rounded up, .4 or lower rounded down):

Points earned toward letter	Freshmen & Soph.	Juniors and Seniors
Minimum 2 points	95 average or higher	93 average or higher
3-4 points	94 average or higher	92 average or higher
5+ points	92 average or higher	90 average or higher
