

## **Dual Enrollment**

(formerly called "Move On When Ready")

Earn High School AND College Credit, Full-time or Part-time!

Registration Deadlines: Fall - July 1, Spring - December 1, Summer - May 1

In order to register for classes, students must first complete application process and be admitted to DSC.

## **Academic Requirements:**

10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade status 3.0 GPA in Core Courses Qualifying SAT **or** ACT Scores *(no other tests accepted)* 

**SAT:** 25 Reading Test (converts to 450 on old test)

530 Math Section (converts to 500 on old test) 970 Combined (minimum 970 after Reading Test and Math Section scores are converted to old test)

ACT: 19 English

21 Math

20 Composite

- Determine Academic Eligibility with your High School Counselor

  Agreement with High School Counselor
- 3. Apply to Dalton State College via GAfutures.org and provide:
  - Official High School Transcript
  - Official College Transcript (if you have taken dual enrollment courses at any other college)
  - Official SAT or ACT Scores
  - Driver's License or US Passport
     or Original Birth Certificate
  - o Immunization Records
