## HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL PERMISSION SLIP

Our system is celebrating Solar Eclipse Day on August 21, 2017. An important part of the day’s activities is viewing this eclipse from outside or virtually (via computer) from inside the school building. The school system is providing protective eyewear for each student. Because looking at the sun directly, including during a partial eclipse, is potentially dangerous, each STUDENT MUST HAVE A SIGNED PERMISSION SLIP IN ORDER TO VIEW THE SOLAR ECLIPSE OUTDOORS.

Those who do not return this signed permission slip will only be able to view the VIRTUAL ECLIPSE from a viewing area indoors.

### Directions:

Please place a check next to the option you prefer. Sign, date, and return this form to your child’s teacher on Monday, August 21st. Students will show permission form to 3rd block teacher and turn in form to 4th block teacher.

\_\_\_\_ (#1) I am giving permission for my child to view the Solar Eclipse (on August 21, 2017) from an **OUTDOOR** viewing area. Because of the potential danger to the EYES, I understand that my child is expected to follow ALL instructions related to this event. Therefore, my child will

- wear protective glasses when directly observing the sun.
- only remove these glasses after he/she has finished looking directly at the sun.

\_\_\_\_ (#2) I am giving permission for my child to view the Solar Eclipse from an indoor viewing area.

**Note:** By signing this note you are stating that you understand that **if your child does not follow ALL safety instructions**, s/he will be escorted to the cafeteria to watch the remainder of the eclipse virtually. Neither the teacher, principal, the county superintendent nor the Board of Education will be held responsible for any physical injury sustained by a student due to improper behavior or by not following instructions.
