

HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL FRESHMAN REGISTRATION GUIDE FOR THE 2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR

Students take a total of 8 classes each year. You must have 4 classes in each core area (English, math, social studies, science) over 4 years to graduate. In addition, freshmen take Health and Personal Fitness (which are 9 weeks each and count together as one class), and Introduction to Digital Technology.

It is important that you enter each number correctly when you request your classes.

If you are a special education student, your core courses will already be selected.

HOPE Rigor requirements: Over 4 years of high school, students must pass 4 classes from the Rigor Classes list (found on the HHS website) in order to be eligible for HOPE Scholarships or Zell Miller Scholarships.

If you select an honors or AP class, the deadline for dropping it is May 25, 2018. Any AP class is a college level class and is taught and graded as such. After May 25, teacher schedules will be set, and we cannot make changes. Students who plan to attend a four year college are encouraged to take honors classes and AP classes.
