- Testing
 - See your counselor for a testing referral form to take the test free on GNTC's campus
 - Once per semester, GNTC will provide ACCUPLACER testing at no charge at HHS, see your counselor to get on testing list
- Apply online at www.gntc.edu (new applicants create new user account), be sure and select Dual Enrollment as application type.
- Complete DE Student Participation Agreement with your HHS Counselor
- Registration appt. at GNTC held in late June or early October
- Complete DE funding application through GAFutures (gafutures.org)

State Funding covers: Application fee, parking fee, class/lab fees, required textbooks/class resources, TUITION for Fall, Spring, AND Summer semesters!
