TEEN MAZE is a life-sized interactive role-play where students navigate stations that offer real life choices & risky behaviors such as drinking/ drugs, teen pregnancy, or contracting an STD. Along the path, health experts present information to help them handle the problems they might face as a result of their behaviors. Since paths are randomly assigned, no two students will have the same experience, much as in real life! The ultimate goal of TEEN MAZE is on-time high school graduation!

In this game, students are victims of chance and must experience whatever happens to them – but, of course, in real life, they have choices! This event is designed to improve student’s knowledge of health risks and realize it is UR CHOICE/ UR DESTINY! Students will be encouraged to learn from their peers’ experiences in the maze and to discuss their experiences with their parents.
